**Schedule:** **Friday** – Youth Show begins at 1:00. **Saturday** – Single ring Sr. Doe Show, Double ring Jr. Doe Show. Show Starts at 8:00 AM. Club Meeting Saturday evening. PDGA Youth Representative Contest. **Sunday** – Sr. Doe Show - Show begins at 8:00 AM

**Directions:** The State Show will be held at the Centre County Fairgrounds in Centre Hall. Centre Hall is located approximately 12 miles from State College, PA on Route 144. The fairgrounds are located in the center of town. Watch for Grange Fair entrance signs. Use gates 2 and 3. Vendors are asked to donate one item per day to the raffle table...Class **Sponsors and Raffle Table Items - Appreciated!**

1. **SHOW ORDER** . . . . This show is sanctioned by ADGA and their rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior shows **are** separately sanctioned. Sr. Doe show starts at 8:00AM. Saturday and Sunday. **Senior** show order will be Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grade. **Youth Show order:** Alpine, Nubian, AOP, Recorded Grade.  
**The show committee has the right to change the show order if they see fit.**
2. **JUNIOR DOE SHOW** . . . . Double ring Jr. Doe show will be held on Saturday following the Sr. doe show. Show order will be Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian, Nubian, AOP, and Recorded Grade. After Alpines are finished in ring 1 they will move to ring 2 and follow the above show order.
3. **CHECK IN** . .... Saturday & Sunday - All animals must be checked in by **7:45 AM**. Friday- Youth must be checked in by **12:45 PM**.
4. **ANIMAL REGISTRATION** . . . . Base date of animals is to be the day the animals are shown. The original registration certificate is required for all animals over 6 months. Animals under 6 months must have a stamped duplicate application, stamped duplicate fax or registration certificate. All papers must be shown to the show secretary prior to show. No copies, telephone calls or telegrams will be accepted in lieu of original papers.
5. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS** . . . . Current health papers must accompany animals originating from your home state. All animals must be listed on an official AAI-13 Health Certificate. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. DO NOT UNLOAD UNTIL SHOW COMMITTEE OR VET CHECKS YOUR ANIMALS!** Animals showing signs of infectious or contagious disease (soremouth pinkeye, abscesses, ringworm) but not limited to will be barred from the show. The decision of the Show Committee and appointed Vet will be final.
6. **PEN FEES**..... There is a \$1.00 per pen fee to be paid along with entries. Every pen used no matter if for goat, tack or sleeping is still \$1.00. There will be no refrigerators or cooking devices in the barns for fire safety reasons.
7. **ENTRY FEES** . . . . **Youth show** per animal \$3.50 or \$3.00 for PDGA or WPDGA youth member. **Open** show per animal for one ring \$4.50 two rings \$7.50 with a .50 discount for PDGA & WPDGA members. There will be a \$2.00 entry fee for Miss Pennsylvania accepted until time of judging. Send all entries to Show Chairman: Gwen Musselman 622 Lafayette Road New Enterprise PA 16664. Make checks payable to **PDGA**. Return check fee is \$50. No refunds for any reason. **\*\*Entries day of Show Should be cash only\* and no membership discount will be taken on day of show.**
8. **NO SMOKING** . . . . No smoking allowed in or around Barn Area and Show Ring.
9. **DOGS** . . . . Dogs should be restrained and kept out of the goat barns and show ring.
10. **FOOD** . . . . Food Stand will be provided by CCE club
11. **EXCLUSION OF RESPONSIBILITY** . . . . PDGA will not be responsible for any accidents or loss to persons, property, or animals while on the fairgrounds.
12. **BICYCLES**...No bicycles, roller blades or skateboards allowed in or around Barn Area and Show Ring.
13. **RV CAMPERS: \$25. Per night. Primitive camping (No electric or water) \$12. Per night**

All participants will judge two or three classes of goats (depending on availability of animals). Ribbons will be awarded.

### **PDGA OUTSTANDING YOUTH AWARDS**

PDGA is going to be offering an OUTSTANDING YOUTH AWARD for both the Junior and Senior youth based on participation in all of the following categories.

1. Your percentage score based on 100 derived from the placement of each of 2 or 3 judging class of 4 animals each.
2. The placement of your top three dairy goats owned by you. The scoring will be 300 for 1st, 280 for 2nd, 250 for 3rd, 240 for a 4th, and 220 for 5th place.
3. A dairy goat show and management test worth a total of 300 points.
4. Your placement in the showmanship class: 300 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 280 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 260 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 240 for 4<sup>th</sup>, 220 for 5<sup>th</sup>, and all others get 200.
